

# GradCru Day of Prayer Guide

- **Adoration:** Praising God for who he is. (Psalm 148:1-14)
  
- **Confession:** Heartfelt Repentance. (Psalm 66:18)
  
- **Thanksgiving and Praise:** Expressing gratitude for what God has done. (Psalm 7:17-8:1, 95:1-7)
  
- **Supplication/Intercession:** Asking God for yourself and others. (1 John 5:14-15; James 1:5-8; Philippians 2:3-4)

  - **Friends and Roommates:**
  
  - **Others who the Lord has put in your path (e.g., department, cohort, lab, office):** Especially for those who aren't yet believers. Ask the Lord to give you opportunity to talk with them about the gospel. (Philippians 2:3-4)
  
  - **Church and Pastors/Elders:**
  
  - **Those in Leadership (e.g., Adviser, Professor, US Government/President):** (1 Timothy 2:1-2)
  
  - **GradCru:** The Lord will use GradCru to expose many grads to the gospel, establish many believers in their faith, and equip many to serve as ambassadors for Christ.
  
  - **Those in your Bible Study Group:**
  
  - **Yourself:** Bring your needs and desires to the Lord.
  
- **Listen for the Lord to speak to your heart:** Take time to listen for the Lord to speak into your mind and heart. God may speak to you through his Word, through your thoughts, through conversations with others, and through circumstances.
